Prayer in this application is for permission to place on record the account statement and audit report of the assessee/present petitioner-cum-applicant.

Application is allowed subject to just exceptions.

The account statement and audit report of the assessee/present petitioner-cum-applicant is taken on record.

CWP No.7639 of 2015

Counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance with the communications, which have been received by the petitioner from the respondents, the requisite documents have been supplied, which were called for vide a communication dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P-4). Despite the said documents having been supplied, the supply of diesel and petrol was discontinued with effect from 01.01.2015 and till date the same has not been

restored.

Counsel contends that the petitioner is suffering losses because of non-supply of the diesel and petrol and the outlet is not working. He had been pursuing the matter with the respondents and had even served a notice through counsel dated 19.01.2015 (Annexure P-6), which has not been responded to.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Divisional Manager, Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Bathinda-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 19.01.2015 (Annexure P-6) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to Divisional Manager, Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Bathinda-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 19.01.2015 (Annexure P-6), within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
