Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to release pension, pensionary benefits and remaining amount of Provident Fund granting and adding benefit of Assured Career Progression scheme along with interest on all these amounts @18% per annum from the date of retirement of petitioner till actual payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits the factum that entire payments have been released during the pendency of present petition. However, no interest has been paid on the delayed payment.

In view of the statement, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, in case the petitioner moves a representation qua the interest on the delayed payment within one

month from the receipt of certified copy of this order, the same shall be disposed of in terms of judgment ***D. D. Tewari (D) through LRs Vs. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. and others***, passed in ***Civil Appeal No.7113 of 2014***, decided on 01.08.2014, within 4 months after the receipt of said representation.
