**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

By this petition the petitioner has challenged the order dated 14/21.07.1993 whereby he was discharged from service.

The petitioner joined the Border Security Force (BSF) as a Constable on 10.06.1988. By order dated 21.07.1993 he was discharged from service on the ground that he had some domestic problem. On 12.12.2004 the petitioner sent a legal notice challenging the said discharge order i.e. after a period of 11 years. It appears from the record that thereafter against the said discharge order the petitioner also moved some statutory petition in the year 2013 i.e. after another period of 9 years and the

same was dismissed on the ground of delay. I see no reason to take a different view to that taken in the said petition.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
