By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks to issue directions to the respondents to release the retirement-cum-service benefits along with interest for delayed period.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice (Annexure P-2), however, the same has not been decided so far. Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
