Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to allot an alternate house to the petitioners under the Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme 2006.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he wants to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a detailed and comprehensive representation. Further prayer was made that time bound directions may be issued to the respondents for disposal of the representation in the event of filing of representation by the petitioners.
