The present writ petition has been filed by the five previous Panches of Gram Panchayat Village Mehtabpur, Tehsil and Block Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur challenging the order dated 6.12.2014 passed by the Director Development and Panchayats, Punjab whereby two resolutions dated 28.7.2011 (P-2) and 5.8.2011 (P-3) passed by the previous Panchayat comprising of the present petitioners, has been set aside on the ground that no proper opportunity had been extended to the private respondent no.4 Gian Chand before recording a finding that he had failed to obey the dictate of the Panchayat in presenting himself before the Panchayat for resolution of the matrimonial dispute on complaint from one Anita against the son of respondent no.4. From the perusal of the resolutions and the impugned order it is apparent that it does not really relate to any of the

functions of the Panchayat under the Panchayati Raj Act, 1994. The matter was only regarding social issue which was being pursued in the right earnest by the members of the erstwhile Panchayat. Even passing of the impugned order does not really reflect upon the conduct of any of the members of the previous Panchayat.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the Caveator/respondent no.4 submits that his client would not derive any benefit from any observations in the impugned order dated 06.12.2014 (P-10) against the petitioners.

In view of the stand of the complainant/respondent no.4, learned Counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
