By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to make payment of her retiral dues along with interest @ 18% per annum on delayed payment.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of her grievance, the petitioner had moved representation Annexure P-5, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the representation (Annexure P-5), by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment.
