Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is covered in his favour by a judgment of a Division Bench of this Court passed in LPA No.920 of 2012, decided on 01.10.2012, titled as **Arya College Rishi Dayanand Marg and another Vs. State of Punjab and others**, along with other connected matters.

In respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition, a legal notice is stated to have been served upon the respondents on 09.11.2014, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-9 with the petition.

He further submits that he would be satisfied, at this stage, if a direction is issued to the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice within a specified period.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice by passing a speaking order within a period of 2

months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner, or any part thereof, is found due, the same shall be released to him, within a period of 2 months thereafter.

However, of course, if for any legally valid reason, the relief sought by the petitioner, or any part thereof, is not found due, such reasons for denial thereof, shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
