By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the payment of gratuity, computed value of pension and to pay the full regular monthly pension instead of provisional pension.

The learned counsel contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in case **State of Jharkhand and others Vs. Jitendra Kumar Srivastava and another, 2013(4) SCT 429.**

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same, in the light of the judgment in Jitendra Kumar Srivastava's case (supra) by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment.
