The grievance of the petitioner is that e-tender inviting applications for Chemist Shop (under Ramp), Block-A in Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh is not a shop reserved for Chemist, though the petitioner has submitted his tender.

We do not find that the petitioner can be permitted to dispute the reservation of e-tender inviting offers from Chemist. If the petitioner feels that shop is not meant for Chemist, it is open to him to withdraw his bid but he cannot be permitted to participate in the tender process and also to say that the shop is not meant for Chemist.

Consequently, the present writ petition is dismissed.
