Prayer in this writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing Award No. 4 dated 16.7.2005 (Annexure P-3) pertaining to plot of the petitioner. Further a direction has also been sought to the respondents to release the plot of the petitioner.
