Anil Kumar Vs. Ranjit Singh and ors.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative of the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of ₹3,15,000/- (₹ Three Lacs Fifteen Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. The enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant – Anil Kumar, through account payee cheque. Learned counsel for the Insurance Company undertakes to produce cheque for the agreed amount of ₹3,15,000/- on 28.8.2015 and deliver it to Mr.Anuj Balian, Advocate for the appellant, otherwise, two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the amount before the MACT, failing which, interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant will furnish bank account particulars with IFS Code to the Insurance Company/MACT.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
