By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to pay the sanctioned reimbursement amount of Rs. 2,01,66/- along with interest @ 18% p.a., from the date of submission of bills till actual payment.

The learned counsel refers to Annexure P-2, whereby the sanction has been accorded for the reimbursement and states that till date nothing has been paid by the respondents.

Keeping in view the fact that only the formal order for the release of medical reimbursement is to be passed, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to take decision on Annexure P-2, the sanction order. The necessary exercise be completed within 45 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and the consequential relief, if any, be released within one months thereafter.
