By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to release the arrears as per the revised pay scale along with interest @ 24% p.a., from the date the arrears become payable till actual payment.

It is asserted that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in *The Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar*, 2010(1) SLR 788.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same, in terms of **Hasan Singh Kanwar's** case, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
