The appellants were to file correct addresses of respondents within 20 days from 06.08.2013. That order was not complied with. On 14.03.2014 a period of 10 days was granted for making compliance and the matter was listed for 01.08.2014, however the compliance was not made. Till the next date, same remained uncomplied till the date when the matter was adjourned yet another time.

On 04.09.2014 needful was not done and last opportunity was given to the appellants to comply with the order dated 01.08.2014 within a fortnight making it clear that if compliance was not made legal consequences would follow.

However in the period of a year and a half, neither correct addresses were filed by the appellants nor any request was made for substituted service giving reasons, thereof.

In view of the clear orders passed on the last date, the appeal is dismissed.
