The petitioner claims himself to the co-sharer to the extent of 6 Kanal 4 Marlas in a certain parcel of land as noticed in the report dated 3.10.2013 submitted by the Patwari concerned on the application dated 6.11.2012 (P-1) made by the petitioner to the Deputy Commissioner, Moga.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the rest of the co-sharers have got partition proceedings concluded on 23.04.2004 without associating the petitioner.

At the time of hearing realising that the present writ petition is thoroughly misconceived, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition to enable his client to seek his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
