AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for quashing of the orders dated 09.03.2015 and 10.03.2015 (Annexures P-14 and P-15) issued by respondent No.3. Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier approached this Court and filed *Civil Writ Petition No.5591 of 2015* titled as *Taranjit Singh Versus Food Corporation of India* decided on 26.03.2015, when the writ petition was permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to avail of the remedy, as has been provided under Clause XVIII of the MTF. On the statement made by learned senior counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner would file the claim as per Clause XVIII within a period of one week from the date of the order, the Court had given a permission to do so with a direction to the competent authority to decide the said claim expeditiously. Counsel contends that after the passing of this order, orders dated 09.03.2015 and 10.03.2015 (Annexures P-14 and P-15) have been passed after the submission of the claim on 01.04.2015.

This contention of the counsel for the petitioner cannot be

accepted as the claim as per Clause XVIII of the MTF has been filed by the petitioner on 01.04.2015 and these orders are prior thereto.

Counsel for the petitioner insists that these orders are subsequent to the submission of the claim of the petitioner but the same cannot be accepted in the light of the specific dates mentioned therein.

In view of the earlier direction, which has been issued by this Court on 26.03.2015 in *Civil Writ Petition No.5591 of 2015*, no further direction, as has been prayed by the counsel for the petitioner for finalizing the claim of the petitioner submitted on 01.04.2015 within a specified time, can be issued.

The present writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
