By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to count the daily wage service rendered by the petitioner from 01.04.1980 to 13.10.1989 towards retiral/pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had served legal notice Annexures P-7, however, the benefit has not been released so far. It is further asserted that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in **Roop Puri Vs. Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Ltd. and others**, rendered in CWP No. 17899 of 2013, decided on 19.08.2013 (Annexure P-5), by this Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to treat the present petition as a representation and decide the same in terms of Roop Puri's case (supra), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
