By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release the benefits of service rendered by the petitioner as work charge employee and grant pension and other benefits.

The learned counsel contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in **Mangal Singh and others Vs. Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited and others**, rendered in CWP No. 19123 of 2010, decided on 27.04.2011 (Annexure P-4), by this Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to examine and decide claim of the petitioner, in terms of Mangal Singh's case (supra), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
