By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits along with interest for delayed payment @ 18% per annum.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had moved representation dated 20.03.2015 (Annexure P-5), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the representation (Annexure P-5), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioner is found entitled to consequential relief, the same be released to him within two months thereafter.
