Prayer in this application, filed under Section 151, CPC, is for disposing of FAO No.1308 of 2013 in terms of compromise effected between the appellant/claimants and the insurance company-respondent No.3.

Notice of the application has been accepted by Mr.J.P.Sharma, learned counsel for the appellant, who is present in the Court.

Learned counsel for the non-applicant/appellants states at bar that the appellant/claimants have sorted out their disputes and effected a compromise with the Insurance

company-respondent No.3. As per the compromise, insurance company-respondent No.3 has agreed to pay an additional Rs.2,80,000/- to the appellants. He further states at bar that in view of the said averment in the application moved by the insurance company-respondent No.3, he may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal.

Learned counsel for the applicant/respondent No.3 states at bar that the agreed additional amount of Rs.2,80,000/- (Rupees two lacs and eighty thousand only) shall be paid to the appellants by way of a cheque within three weeks from the date of passing of this order.

In view of the above, the present application is accepted.

In view of the order of even date passed in Civil Misc. No.6404-CII of 2015, FAO No.1308 of 2013 is pre-poned and taken on today's roster.

Since the appellant/claimants and the insurance company-respondent No.3 have sorted out their disputes and it has been agreed that additional amount of Rs.2,80,000/- (Rupees two lacs and eighty thousand only) would be paid by the Insurance company to the appellant/claimants within three weeks from passing of this order, learned counsel for the

appellants prays for withdrawal of the present appeal.
