This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to take into account petitioner's entire length of service w.e.f. 18.04.1977 as qualifying service for pension and other retiral-service benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by ratio of law laid down in CWP No.10209 of 2004 titled as Om Pati Vs. State of Haryana and others decided on 26.09.2006 (Annexure P-7), CWP No.2951 of 2009 titled as Sarla Devi Vs. State of Haryana and others decided on 08.03.2010 (Annexure P-8), CWP No.22597 of 2013 titled as Smt. Munni Bai Vs. State of Haryana and others decided on 11.02.2014 (Annexure P-9), CWP No.4663 of 2011 titled as Sudesh Kumari Vs. State of Haryana and others decided on 23.08.2013 (Annexure P-10) and LPA No.1806 of 2012 (O&M) titled as The State of Haryana and others Vs. Smt. Dropati Devi decided on 07.12.2012 (Annexure P-11).

In these circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a

direction to the respondents to examine the representations, one dated 08.04.2013 (Annexure P-5) and another dated 18.02.2015 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner in the light of judgments passed at Annexures P-7 to P-11 within four months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
