AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is being threatened by respondents 4 to 6 and they are not being arrested despite the dismissal of the application for grant of pre-arrest bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. vide order dated 05.03.2015 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib. Counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib dated 26.03.2015 (Annexure P-3) but no response thereto has been received.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioner and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to Senior Superintendent of

Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib-respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation of the petitioner dated dated 26.03.2015 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
