AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that the road starting from Delhi-Mathura Road and ending at Railway Station, Ballabgarh, is in a very bad condition with pits where water-logging is frequent because of which the residents of the area have suffered a lot. They had been approaching the respondents for proper maintenance of the said road but no effective steps have been taken by the respondents.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the road, in part, is to be maintained by the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad-respondent No.3 and the remaining part is to be maintained by HUDA, Faridabad, respondent No.4. Petitioners have submitted representations to both these respondents but without any result. Even the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad-respondent No.2 had been approached by the petitioners through representations but that

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has also not been of any use. Counsel has referred to the various representations which have been submitted by the petitioners, copies of which are appended alongwith the writ petition as Annexures P-1 to P-8.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad; Chief Administrator, HUDA, Faridabad and Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad, respondents 2 to 4 respectively, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners dated 26.06.2014 (Annexure P-8) within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the parties, without going into merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad; Chief Administrator, HUDA, Faridabad and Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad, respondents 2 to 4 respectively, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners dated 26.06.2014 (Annexure P-8) and if the submissions as made by the petitioners in the representation is found to be correct, necessary steps be taken, in accordance with law, at the earliest to redress their grievance preferably within a period of four months.
