JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the services rendered by him in the Government Aided School against an aided post, for the purposes of pensionary benefits.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-4, however, the same has not been decided so far. The learned counsel further submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in CWP No.8668 of 2010, titled as Tarsem Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 10.03.2010 (Annexure P-5).

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the

legal notice, Annexure P-4, in the light of the judgment, Annexure P-5, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
