Short reply dated 18.3.2015 filed by Satyabir Singh, Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate, Gurgaon on behalf of respondent No. 3, filed in Court is taken on record.

Office is directed to place a photocopy of the reply dated 18.3.2015 on the record in the second paper book.

The dispute in the present writ petition is relating to khasra No. 6//1/2 (0-7) total measuring 7 marla situated in the revenue estate of Jhanjhawas, Tehsil and District Rewari.

As per the reply dated 18.3.2015, land measuring 7 marla of the petitioner has already been released. Para 3 of the reply reads as under:-

“That the land measuring 0 kanal 7 marla claimed by the petitioner in the present civil writ petition is not the subject matter of the present acquisition proceedings at this stage because the above said land has already released by the competent authority vide common instruction issued vide letter no. 12/13/2013-3TCP dated 7.11.2014.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the above, the writ petition may be disposed of as infructuous.
