JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to grant interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits i.e. gratuity, leave encashment, etc. The learned counsel cites *Daya Singh Vs. State of Haryana, 2014(3) S.C.T. 211* and *D.D. Tiwari Vs. UHBVNL, 2014(8) SCC 894*.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-3, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the legal notice, Annexure P-3, in the light of the judgments rendered in *Daya Singh* and *D.D. Tiwari* (supra), by passing a speaking

order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
