AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner-Union that respondents 5 to 9 are not permitting the members of the petitioner-Union to ply their vehicles in the city. Not only threats but the members have also been attacked and they have received injuries also. Petitioner has referred to the representation dated 19.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Roop Nagar-respondent No.3 and the Station House Officer, Police Station Morinda, Distirct Roop Nagar-respondent No.4 but no action thereon has been taken.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents 2 and 3 to look into the representation dated 19.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to Deputy Commissioner,

Rupnagar, District Rupnagar-respondent No.2 and Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar-respondent No.3 to consider the representation of the petitioner-Union dated 19.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) and if any substance is found therein, take appropriate steps in accordance with law. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
