Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of direction to the respondents to pay the claims for medical reimbursement.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that entire amount regarding medical reimbursement has been received by him. However, he states that the amount was illegally withheld by the respondent for about 3 years. Therefore, he states that interest on the delayed payment be allowed to him.

Keeping in view the fact that the entire amount stands paid, the present petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to

make a representation in this regard within one month from today with certified copy of this order. The respondents shall consider the same in the accordance with law and pass a speaking order within 4 months after receipt of such representation.
