AJAY TEWARI, J.(ORAL)

By this petition the petitioner has challenged the order whereby interim stay has been vacated. During arguments a limited agreement has been entered into between the learned counsel. In the first place it has been agreed that the petitioner had sought some record of the inquiry from the respondent-college. The respondent-college had agreed that the said record would be made available with the Educational Tribunal tomorrow and the petitioner would be at liberty to inspect the same on 02.05.2015 and 04.05.2015. The second agreement is that no adjournment will be sought on 05.05.2015 and parties will argue the matter. In view of this agreement the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Educational Tribunal, Yamuna Nagar

to hear the main case and decide the appeal on or before 31.05.2015 in accordance with law.

In view of this agreed order, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of. Copy be handed over under signatures of Bench Secretary.
