The challenge in the present writ petition is to an order dated 07.02.2015 passed by the Revenue Officer-cum-Tehsildar, Naib Dabwali, finalizing delimitation of the wards for the Gram Panchayat Assir, Tehsil Dabwali, District Sirsa . Such order has been affirmed in appeal by the Sub Divisional Officer (Civil) on 20.02.2015.

The grievance of the petitioners is that 11 houses falling in Ward No.1 have been shifted to Ward No.2 in a wholly illegal and arbitrary manner without any reasonable basis in the draft notification itself by starting the count of house number not from House No.1 but from House No.12.

We find that this Court while exercising power of judicial review examines the decision making process. The petitioners filed objections to the proposed delimitation of wards. Such objections have been considered by the Revenue Officer and in appeal as well. By such process of delimitation of the wards, no rights of the

petitioner have been violated as he continues to be voter in village may be of different ward. Merely because another view might be possible is not a ground to exercise the writ jurisdiction of this Court to direct the authority to take a different view.

We do not find any error in the decision making process which may warrant interference in the writ jurisdiction of this Court.

Consequently, the present writ petition is dismissed.
