The father of the petitioner late Balkar Singh, who was working as Handling/Labour Gang No.4 of Dharariwal Depot, District Amritsar, under the respondent-Food Corporation of India (hereinafter referred to as the 'Corporation') expired on 27.03.2014 while in service. On his death, the petitioner applied for appointment on compassionate ground. Letters dated 25.05.2014 (Annexure P-3) and 28/29.05.2014 (Annexure P-4), show that the case of the petitioner is under consideration of the respondent-Corporation but in spite of the passage of about one year no final decision has been taken so far.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the matter, I direct respondent No.1 to take a final decision with regard to the case of the petitioner for compassionate appointment, as per the applicable rules of the respondent-Corporation, within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
