Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of the relief claimed in this petition, i.e. for counting of service rendered on work charged basis by the petitioner with the respondents, statedly for 14 years, 3 months and 7 days, a legal notice is stated to have been served on his behalf, upon the respondents, on 24.12.2014, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-5 with the petition.

He submits that, at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice within a specified period.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents, to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. While passing the speaking order, the respondents would take into consideration the decision of the Supreme Court in Punjab State Electricity Board and

another vs Narata Singh and another, as also of a Full Bench of this court in Kesar Chand vs State of Punjab and others 1988(5) SLR 27.

In case the relief sought in this petition, or any part thereof, is found due, the same shall be released to the petitioner within a period of two months thereafter.

If, for any legally valid reasons, the relief sought by the petitioner, or any part thereof, is not found due, detailed reasons for the same shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
