Ravinder Singh, the husband and Charanjit Kaur, the wife are present along with their respective counsel and state that they have decided to part ways by filing a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Bathinda.

Parties have also agreed that ₹4 lacs shall be paid towards permanent alimony at the stage of first motion and another sum of ₹4 lacs shall be paid as full and final settlement of all claims of permanent alimony past, present and future maintenance for the appellant and their child, at the stage of second motion.

As regards arrears of maintenance, the appellant who is

present in the Court states that his salary has been attached and the arrears shall be sent to the respondent by the department in due course namely within a month. The parties also agree that both parties and their relatives shall withdraw all and every case filed against each other or their family members.

In view of the statement of counsel for the parties, the appeal has been rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.
