By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to release all the remaining retiral benefits of the grand mother of the petitioner who died during service.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner had moved representation (Annexure P-2), however, the benefits have not been released so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the representation Annexure P-2, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
