Challenge in the present writ petition is to the orders dated 2.2.2015 and 8.4.2015 (Annexures P6 and P8 respectively) passed by the competent authority whereby the petitioner has been suspended and appeal against the suspension order has already been dismissed on the premise that the petitioner did not co-operate with the audit of the Gram Panchayat.

This Court on 7.5.2015 stayed the operation of the aforementioned order and directed that the petitioner shall join in the upcoming audit.

Mr. Yatinder Sharma, Addl. AG, Punjab submits that the petitioner has joined in the audit of the Gram Panchayat held on 25.5.2015 and since the audit has been conducted and therefore, the basis of the suspension is no longer in existence. Accordingly, aforementioned orders dated 2.2.2015 and 8.4.2015 are set aside with the liberty to the competent authority to take further action, if need be, in accordance with law.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
