The challenge in the present writ petition is to an order dated 18.03.2015 (Annexure P-5) whereby consequent to the order of Election Tribunal, recount of votes of Ward No.8 was conducted wherein the election petitioner was found to have obtained more votes than the present petitioner.

Admittedly, the petitioner has not challenged the order passed by the Election Tribunal ordering for recount. In the absence of challenge to the order passed by the Election Tribunal, the impugned order is a consequential order which cannot be permitted to be challenged in the writ petition.

Consequently, we do not find any merit in the present writ petition.

Dismissed.
