Counsel for the petitioner submits that the arms licence of the petitioner is pending consideration with the Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice (Home-II Branch), Punjab, Chandigarh-respondent No.2. The case of the petitioner for renewal of the licence stands recommended by the concerned authority and a final decision has to be taken by respondent No.2 on the claim of the petitioner for which it has also submitted a representation dated 21.03.2015 (Annexure P-7) to the said respondent No.2 but no decision thereon till date has been taken or conveyed to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 21.03.2015 (Annexure P-7) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Secretary to the Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice (Home-II

Branch), Civil Secretariat, Punjab, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 21.03.2015 (Annexure P-7), within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
