TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Counsel would submit that the petitioner was appointed on a Class IV post vide appointment letter dated 28.01.1992 issued by the Block Education Officer at Annexure P-1.

Grievance raised in the instant writ petition is that while considering the cases for promotion from amongst Class IV employees to the post of Clerk, a number of employees, who were junior to the petitioner and had been appointed initially much after 28.01.1992, their cases have been considered and they have even been promoted.

Argument raised is that the action of the respondent-authorities in denying to the petitioner consideration for promotion to a Class III post inspite of being senior is wholly unjust and violative of Articles 14 & 16 of the Constitution of India.

Without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the claim and grievance of the petitioner and to take a final

decision on the representations dated 22.12.2012 and 23.11.2014 at Annexures P-5 (colly) strictly in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed of.
