Petitioner has approached this Court asserting that respondent No.2 would proceed to seal the premises of the petitioner without complying with the provisions as contained in Section 18 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956. This the counsel asserts on the basis of press report dated 01.05.2015 (Annexure P-2) as also F.I.R. No.176 dated 07.04.2015 (Annexure P-1).

This contention of the counsel for the petitioner is not tenable at this stage as no orders have been passed by the Magistrate under the provisions of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956.

The writ petition at this stage is premature and, therefore, calls for no interference by this Court. Dismissed.
