AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

After arguing the case at length, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner has referred to a communication dated 03.01.2015 (Annexure P-17) which indicates that the rice which the petitioner is required to deliver to the Haryana State Warehousing Corporation-respondent No.3 is intact as per the inspection carried out by the officials of the Corporation and can be delivered even today provided a consent is received in this regard from the said respondent. He contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the District Manager, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation, Ambala, to consider this request and pass appropriate orders within some specified time.

In the light of the statement made by the learned Senior

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Counsel for the petitioner, the present Writ Petition is disposed of without going into merit of the case and commenting thereon, with a direction to the District Manager, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation, Ambala, to decide the application dated 03.01.2015 (Annexure P-17) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

At this stage, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner states that he would move a representation to the Managing Director, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation, Panchkula-respondent No.3 in this regard which will be submitted within a period of one week from today, which may also be directed to be considered and appropriate order passed thereon.

The prayer made by learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner is accepted. In case, such a representation is made within a period of one week from today to the Managing Director, Haryana State Warehousing Corporation, Panchkula-respondent No.3, the same shall be considered and appropriate orders passed thereon by the said respondent, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of such representation.
