By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the official respondents to conclude the enquiry on the basis of the complaint made by the petitioner (Annexure P-1) and further to take suitable action in accordance with law against the private respondents.

The learned counsel contends that on the basis of the complaint dated 16.09.2013 (Annexure P-1), the enquiry was instituted to be conducted by respondent No.3 but till today, the enquiry has not been concluded.

In the circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to conclude the enquiry proceedings, after affording opportunity of hearing to all the interest parties, preferably within a period of four months, by passing a speaking order, from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
