By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to take a decision on the legal notice dated 15.10.2014 (Annexure P-3 colly.)

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served legal notice dated 15.10.2014 (Annexure P-3), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-3, in terms of **State of Kerala Vs. M. Padmanadhan Nair, 1985 SCC Vol-I 429 (SC)**, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
