Petitioners have approached this Court under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to deposit the amount of compensation with the learned Executing Court for disbursement to the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to Annexure P-6, order passed by this Court on 21.5.2014 in CWP No. 9920 of 2014 titled as Sant Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others wherein this Court while disposing of the writ petition has directed the Executing Court to expedite the proceedings in order of priority and adopt all lawful coercive means to ensure that due amount of compensation is paid to the land owners.

3. In view of the aforesaid direction in CWP No. 9920 of 2014,

no further orders are required to be passed in the instant writ petition.

4. Petition stands disposed of.
