RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

The promotion is claimed after 4 years from the date the junior was promoted. The Supreme Court in **P.S.Sadasivaswamy v. State of Tamilnadu** 1976 (1) SLR 53 : AIR 1974 SC 2271 has in cases of promotion laid down that stale cases should not be entertained by the writ Court and that normally, promotion cases should be assailed within 6 months to one year of the date from which the alleged junior has been promoted. Repeated requests do not give a cause of action as held by the constitution bench in **S.S.Rathore v. State of M.P.** AIR 1990 SC 10.

No ground is made out warranting grant of relief in extraordinary writ jurisdiction.

The petition stands dismissed.
