This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for quashing the impugned action of the respondents whereby the period of past regular service rendered by the petitioners is not being counted for the purpose of pensionary benefits and for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the past regular service for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

It has been averred in the petition that petitioners approached this Court for redressal of their grievance without approaching to the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners made many efforts, but they were not entertained. However, no such representation is on record.

In these circumstances, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to treat the present petition as representation of the petitioners and decide the same, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
