After addressing arguments for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays that the writ petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate petition under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the “1961 Act”). Counsel for the petitioner also prays that as the Gram Panchayat is about to dispossess the petitioner, the petitioner's possession may be protected till it files a petition under Section 11 of the 1961 Act.

We have heard counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, dismiss the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Collector under Section 11 of the Act.

The Gram Panchayat shall not interfere with the petitioner's possession **for a period of ten days** from today.
