By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 07.11.2013 (Annexure P6) and order dated 12.11.2014 (Annexure P8), vide which the claim with regard to pension and other retiral benefits after counting the previous service of the petitioner prior to regularization has been rejected.

The learned counsel contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by judgment of this Court in case **Sat Parkash** Vs. **State of Haryana and others**, rendered in CWP No. 14088 of 2012, decided on 09.10.2013 (Annexure P-9) and he will be satisfied in case, the respondent is directed to examine the case of the petitioner in the light of Annexure P-9.

In the circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent, to examine the case of the petitioner in terms of **Sat Parkash's** case (supra), by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found to be entitled to the relief sought, the consequential benefits shall be released within one month thereafter.
