Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside order dated 10.07.2014 (Annexure P/10) passed by respondent no.1 – Financial Commissioner, Haryana, order dated 25.08.2009 (Annexure P/7) passed by respondent no.3 – Collector, Sub Division Safidon.

The Financial Commissioner has rightly set aside order dated 29.06.2010 (Annexure P/8) passed by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, by observing that all the co-sharers should be given proportionate share as per their entitlement near the abadi. In view of this, I do not find any perversity or illegality in the order passed by the Financial Commissioner.

Dismissed in limine.
