Appellant has filed this appeal against order dated 25.4.2013, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar, vide which the application of the appellant under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 was dismissed. In the said application, the prayer was made to restrain respondent No.1 -Bank from releasing the amount of bank guarantee to respondent No.1

Learned counsel for the appellant has informed that after the passing of the order dated 29.4.2013, directing the appellant to deposit Rs.2 crore within one month, respondent No.1 has got encashed three bank guarantees of the appellant.

It being so, the present appeal has become infructuous and is disposed of as such.
